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And now here at the said third Tuesday in November came
his Lordship by Serch Francis his Atty and prays
that the said Thomas Vason to the Information of Inform
do may answer

And now here the same day and year last mentioned
came the said Thomas Vason and in his proper person
appears

And the same Thomas Vason comes and defends
the force and Injury wherein &c. and sayeth that he cannot
gain say the Information of &c. as against him brought
nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises above
upon him imposed as by the said Information it is alleged
and therefore he submits to the Court therefore it is
considered by the Justice here to wit at Court County
at the Court house in the town of Cheston in said County
on the third Tuesday of November being the Nineteenth
day of said Month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven
Hundred thirty and four that the said Thomas Vason
be fined the sum of five Hundred pounds of Tobacco
according to Act of Assembly in such case made and
provided and that two Hundred and fifty pounds of
Tobacco half the sum of the above five Hundred pounds
of Tobacco be applied to the use of his Lordship
and the remaining Two Hundred and fifty pounds
of Tobacco be applied to and for the free school in said
County and it is also considered that the same Thomas
Vason pay the sum of Two Hundred and forty two pounds
of Tobacco costs remaining on the premises of &c. to the
officers of this Court

His Lordship The said Thomas being Constable
of Lower South Sassafras Hundred
Thomas Vason did not take the taxables of a certain
James Greenwood according to
Act of Assembly thereupon this Court orders that
his Lordship Clerk of Indictments Exhibit an
Information against the said Thomas Vason for
the offence of &c. after which came the said Atty and
Exhibited the Information as follows
