orders his clerks of Auditors for said town to exhibit
an Information against the same Thomas Tason for the
offence aforesaid after which came the said atty and
exhibited the Information as follows viz
Hert County ss. Be it remembered that
Tench Francis Esq. atty. of the Right Honorable
Lord proprietary that now is & he for the same Lord
proprietary in this part prosecuteth doth come here
into the County Court of the same Lord praying held
for the County aforesaid to wit at the Court house at
Chertown town in the County aforesaid the nineteenth day
of November in the Year of our Lord God Seventeen
hundred thirty and four before James Harris Esq.
and his Associates the said Lord praying has Justices
of said County Court and for the same Lord propriety
doth give the same Justice here to understand and
be informed that a certain Thomas Tason of Lower
South Saxons Hundred in the County aforesaid planter
on the third Tuesday of November which was in the
year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred thirty and two
and always afterwards untill the day of the Exhibition
of this Information being an Inhabitant and Resident
within the said Hundred and County and within the
Jurisdiction of this Court and a fit man to execute the office
of a constable in the Hundred and County aforesaid was legally
and in due form then and there elected and appointed to
be the constable of said Hundred of which said Election
and Appointment the same Thomas afterwards to wit
the same day and year last mentioned at the place aforesaid had
Retained the Oath of a constable of the Hundred aforesaid in due
form of Law did take and the said Thomas was and continues
constable of the said Hundred from the said third Tuesday
of November in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred
thirty and two until the twenty first day of June
