At which said third Tuesday of November being
 the Nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen
 hundred thirty four the day of Return of said writ
 came in Gresham and gave the said Sheriff of Kent County and
 made return thereof to the Court here thereof, and so
 as follows Vizt

And now here at the third Tuesday in November came
 his Majesty's Lordship by Trench Francis his Attly and prays
 that the said Tho. Tason to the Information of ~~in~~ force
 do may answer

And now here the same day and year last mentioned
 came the said Thomas Tason and in his proper person appears

And the same Thomas Tason comes and defends
 the force and injury whereto: Sayeth that he cannot
 gain say the Information of so, and against him brought
 nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises above
 upon him imposed as by the said Information it is eldged
 and therefore he submits to the Court Therefore it is
 considered by the Justices here to wit at Kent County at
 the Court house in the town of Chestor in County on
 third Tuesday of Nov^r being the Nineteenth day of said moⁿ
 Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred thirty and four
 that the said Tho. Tason be fined the sum of five Hundred pds
 of tobacco according to Act of Assembly in such case made
 and provided and that two Hundred and fifty pds tob^a
 half the above sum of five Hundred pounds of tobacco be
 applied to the use of his Majesty's Lordship and the remaining two hundred
 and fifty pds of tob^a be applied to the free school in said
 County And it is also considered that the same Tho. Tason
 pay the sum of two Hundred and fifty one pds tob^a cost
 arising on the premises to the officers of this
 Court
