Wingg old of Longford Bay Lower Hundred in the County of Kent plantor if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe keep so that he have his Body before our Justice of said County Court to be held at our Court house in the town of Cheston in said County on the third Tuesday of November instant to answer unto a certain Information for not repairing in person to the dwelling house of a certain Alexander Johnson of the said Hundred and County plantor and there require a true list under his hand of all his taxable persons distinctly to be made which he had in his family but so to do altogether did Neglect against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made &c and that the Sheriff of Kent County have at the time and place of the said Writ &c
