Recognizance with Security for her Appearance at the next Court of Assize to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the twenty fifth Day of April next Ensuing as an Evidence for his Lordship against the said Henry Spencer

Thereupon Nathol Rite of Kent County Esquire and Edward Butcher of Kent County Platter Acknowledged the several Indebtedness unto the right honourable the said Lord Prop^r in the Sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland Each to be made and Secured on their Body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Lordship his heirs and Successors shall not make her personal Appearance at the next Court of Assize to be held for the County afo^r at the time and place afo^r then they be to Testify as an Evidence for his Lordship against the said Henry Spencer, Wherewith they and Each of them Acknowledged themselves Content

And now here at this Day to wit the sixteenth day of Nov^r in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty six before the said Volentine Lynton here into Court in his proper person and with that he ^{is} not ^{guilty of} assault the said Richard Groscham

Ordered by this Court that the said Volentine give Security for his Appearance ^{and good behaviour} to next and he having no Security to produce to the Court. Thereupon he is committed into the Custody of Sheriff of Kent County untill he give Security as afo^r
