The ap. Evidence being sworn to the grand Jury and the Jury Return the following Indictment. It is shewn by the Jury for the Right Honourable the Lord Prop. that now is for the County of Chester ap. Upon their Oath do present that Hugh O'Neil late of said County Parish in the County of Chester the birthday of January Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty six at the Parish ap. in the County of Chester and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain George Newin in the place of God and of the said Lord Prop. then and there being with force and arms an assaulted and maimed and the same George then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life was greatly distressed and other harm to him then and there did to the great damage of the same George and against the peace of the said Lord Prop. his good rule and Government &c

Hugh in his proper person cometh and doth deny the force and injury whereof And saith that he cannot gainway the Indictment ap. as against him brought nor but that he is guilty of the promises above upon him imposed as by the ap. Indictment it is alleged and thereupon Submits to the Court
