 Subscriber One of his Lordships Justice of the Peace for the County of
 Mary Crook and acknowledged herself indebted unto the Lord Proprietor
 in the sum of Ten pounds current money of Maryland to be made and
 conveyed on your body goods and Chattle Vans & Tenements to the
 use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition
 that she the said Mary Crook do make her personal appearance
 before the Justice of our most Honorable Court to be held at our Court-
 house in Chester Town on the third Tuesday of March next then
 and there to satisfy in behalf of his Lordship against the said Mary
 Wright on Suspicion of Felony Where this recognizance to be
 void she to remain in full force in Law - Ebenezer Blackiston
 The said Evidence being sworn to the grand Jury after which they
 Return the following Indictment

Hent County ss. The Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord
 Proprietary that now is for the body of Hent County and upon their
 Oath do present that Margaret Wright late of Shroverbury Parish
 in the County of the wife of Thomas Wright of the same Parish &
 County and planter the tenth day of February Anno Domini seventeen
 hundred thirty six at the Parish and in the County and within
 the Jurisdiction of this Court with force and arms & a pair of
 Womens Stockings of the price of thirty pounds of tobacco and a
 Womens Jackett of the price of forty pounds of tobacco of the goods
 and Chattle of a certain Philip Smithfield then and there being found
 then and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to
 the peace of the said Lord Proprietor his good rule and Government and
 against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and
 provided &c

 for the good Behaviour on the proper and to the Officers of this Court
