 day of said month in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred thirty six
 Cometh hereto Court William Mafy in his proper person and
 prayeth that his recognizance taken aforesaid may be discharged
 Ordered by this Court here that the said William his recognizance
 taken aforesaid may be discharged as prayed

William Mafy his recognizance taken aforesaid is by this
 Court here discharged there being no Lawd shew to the contrary

His Honorship of Kent County J. B. Well remembered
Henry Spencer that on the fiftenth day of April in the
 year of our Lord seventeen hundred thirty six
 came before me the Subscriber One of his Honorship Justice of the
 Peace for the County and Anthony Wright and acknowledged himself
 indebted unto the Lord Proprietary in the sum of twenty pounds
 current money of Maryland to be made and payed on your body
 goods and chattels bonds and judgments to the use of his said Lord-
 ship his heirs &c. with condition that if he the said
 Anthony do make his personal appearance before the Justice
 of our next County Court to be held at our Courthouse in the Town of
 Charles on the third Tuesday of June next then and there to testify
 in behalf of his Honorship against the said Henry Spencer on
 suspicion of felony That this recognizance to be void Else to remain
 in full force and Virtue in Law Edw. Pearce

The said Anthony Wright being sworn to to the grand Jury
 after which they returned the following presentment
 We the grand Jury for Kent County do present Henry Spencer
 of said County for feloniously killing four Hogs and bearing
 them away contrary to Act of Assembly the owner being unknown
