

Well of the grand Jurors for Kent County do Present Agulla
 Peaca for assaulting Mathew Howard of Bordley foramen
 Kent County & The Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord Prop^r
 that now is for the City of Kent County and upon their Oath do Present
 that Agulla Peaca late of Saint Pauls Parish in the County of Kent
 the Eighteenth day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty
 and Six at the Parish of in the County and Within the Jurisdiction
 of this Court in and upon a certain Mathew Howard in the Peace
 of God and of the said Lord Prop^r then and there being with force
 and Arms an Assault did make and the same Mathew then and
 there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his Person greatly
 dispaired and other harm to him then and there done to the great
 Damage of the same Mathew and against the Peace of the said
 Lord Proprietary his good rule and Government

On the Verdict of the said Indictment was Returned as follows

True Bill Shown as Bordley foramen

And now here to wit at Kent County and at the Court house in the
 Town of Chester on the day and year and month this said Lord Prop^r
 by Francis Francis his Attorney and Prayers that the said Agulla do
 to the Indictment in right answer

And the said Agulla in his proper person come and defend
 the force and injury when do and saith that he cannot gainway
 the Indictment as so as against him brought nor can he
 say but that he is guilty of the premises and above upon him
 Imposed as by the said Indictment it is alleged and there
 he submits to the Court

Therefore is considered by the Justices here to wit
 at the Court house in the Town of Chester on the day and year and
 that the said Agulla pay the sum of Ten Shillings current
 money of Maryland as a fine for committing the said Offence
 Also it is considered by the Justices and that the said Agulla
 pay the sum of two hundred and ninety two Pounds of
 Tobacco
