that he immediately cometh to com her hoolid by whom

year of our return that he hath her ready hoolid & as
by his precept he was commanded And now here after ward
to wit the day and year last mentioned and again the said
Proprietor's Attorney and the said Katharine
person and the Jurors of that Jury being impanelled and called
likewise came to wit Edward Worrell, James Ringgold, Benj.
Ruand, John Hodges, Edward Conner, Francis Barney, John
Williams, Robert White, Robert Moots, Abner Redgrave,
Richard Pearce, Joseph Gleason, who being duly Oathed
tried & sworn to say the truth in the premises the Plaintiff
appearing by his Attorney and the Verdict of Jury and upon
their Oath do say that the said Katharine is guilty as she stands
charged. By Edward Worrell their Foreman all so say &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at
Kent County and at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said
County on the third Tuesday of June being the day of year and that the
said Katharine pay the sum of five pounds current money of
Maryland according to Act of Assembly as a fine for committing
the said Offense — Also to pay the sum of One thousand
Seven hundred & to be paid forth with in on the premises and
to the several Officers of this Court &c

Ordered by this Court here that the fine and be delivered the
Sheriff of Kent County &c

And she not having where withall to satisfy the same nor
one offering to do it for her. Thereupon she is committed
into the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County until the fine and
