Thereupon Henry Spencer, John Pyley & Thomas Smith
of Kent County Planters & present herein Court in their proper
persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Right Honour-
able the Lord Proprietary that is to say Henry Spencer in the sum
of fifty pounds current money of Maryland and John Pyley and
Thomas Smith in the sum of twenty five pounds like money Each
to be made and Sweyed on your Body goods and Chattels Lands
& Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & assigns
With condition that if he the said Henry Spencer do make
his personal appearance before the Justices of our next Aug.
Court then and there to answer unto such things as be objected ag-
ainst him on behalf of his Lordship Then this Recognizance to be
void & to remain in full force in Law

Ordered by this Court that Anthony Wright enter into
Recognizance for his appearance at August Court next following
as an Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the said Henry
Thereupon Thomas Agnew of Kent County Gentleman &
present herein Court acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord
Propy of this Province in the sum of ten pounds current money of
Maryland to be made and Sweyed on your body goods & Chattels
Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs &
assigns With condition that if the said Anthony Wright do
make his personal appearance before the Justices of our next
August Court to testify as an Evidence against the said Henry
Spencer Then this Recognizance to be void & to remain
in full force in Law

This Lordship's Command was given the Sheriff of
Kent County on the twenty first day
Edith Street of March in the year of our Lord Seventeen
hundred thirty six that he should take
Edith Street late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Westminster &
