And the said Nathaniel in his proper person come and defende the said and Injuriy when & wher saith that he cannot gain say the Judgement of the Court against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises and above upon him imposed as by the said Judgement it is alledged & thereupon Submitte to the Court &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at Kent County and at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the day & year as last mentioned that the said Nathaniel pay the sum of One Pound current money of Maryland as a fine for committing the said offense — Also it is considered that the said Nathaniel pay the sum of three hundred & ten pounds of tobacco Cents accruing on the premises and to the Officers of this Court &c

Ordered by this Court here that the fine and be delivered the Sheriff of Kent County and William Harris Gentleman Sheriff of Kent County and present here in Court as a receipt of the same
