Ordered by this Court here that Martha Macfield enter into Recognizance for her appearance to August Court next answering as an Evidence against the said John Thorn

Thereupon Morgan Sturt of Kent County planter did present herein Court acknowledged himself indebted unto the Lord Proprietor of this Province in the sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland to be made & levied on your body goods and chattels & under attachment to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors With Condition that the said Martha do make her personal appearance before the Justice of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Charles in said County on the third Tuesday of August next then and there to abide in behalf of his Lordship against the said John Thorn. Then this Recognizance to be void else to remain in full force in Law

Ordered by this Court here that Richard Cromb give Security for his appearance to next Court as an Evidence in behalf of his Lordship against the said John Thorn

Thereupon Morgan Sturt of Kent County planter & present herein Court in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted unto the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of this Province in the sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland to be made & levied on your body goods and
