The Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Kent County and upon their Oath do present that Samuel Hudson late of Saint Pauls Parish in the County of Laborer the twenty first day of June Anno Domini seven hundred thirty seven at the parish aforesaid in the County of and within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Edward Rogers in the fear of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and threatened Edward Rogers then & there did beat wound and willfully break that of his life it was greatly impaired and other harm to him then and there did to the great damage of the said ~~Lord Proprietary~~ ^{Edward Rogers} and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary his good Rule & Government &c
