And the said Anne her proper person come and defend the force and injury when by and Prayers that she cannot gain say the Judgment of the Court against her brought nor can she say but that she is guilty of the premises as abased upon her Jurors as by the said Judgment it is alleged and thereupon Submits to the Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at Kent County and at the Court house in Chester Town on the day and year afo that the said Anne pay the sum of thirty Shillings current money of Maryland as a fine for committing the said Offence Also it is considered at the time and place afo that the said Anne pay the sum of three hundred and nine pounds of Tobacco to be delivered on the premises afo to the several Officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court that the said Anne be committed to the Sheriff of Kent County and William Harris Esq. to be present herin Court acknowledge the receipt of the same Ordered by this Court that the said Anne give security for the fees of carrying on the premises afo to the several Officers of this Court And she having no one to offer nor no one offering for her Surety she is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County until the fees afo be satisfied as afo
