42.04 feet short of the end thereof, thence, along the Northerly right of way line of the Bark Hill Road, (12) South 85 degrees 00' 00" West 228.50 feet to a point, thence, along the rear of lots 19 through 12 of a subdivision recorded in plat book #3, page 3, so as to exclude said lots, (13) South 18 degrees 00' 00" West 615.54 feet and passing over a three-fourths inch iron pipe at the end of 42.04 feet, thence, along the Northerly lot line of lot #11, it being the land of Harry F. Carr recorded in Liber 191, Folio 9, (14) North 72 degrees 00' 00" West 190.00 feet to a point on the Westerly right of way line of Main Street, thence, along said Westerly right of way line so as to exclude lots in "Bowman's Addition to Union Bridge," (15) South 18 degrees 00' 00" West 102.00 feet to a point, thence three lines to include lands conveyed unto the Board of Education, (16) North 60 degrees 15' 00" West 475.24 feet, (17) South 18 degrees 00' 00" West 483.50 feet, (18) South 72 degrees 00' 00" East 245.40 feet, thence, along the Westerly right of way line of a 16' alley shown on a plat of "Clemson's Addition to Union Bridge," and recorded in Liber 142, Folio 155, (19) South 18 degrees 00' 00" West 726.00 feet to a point, thence, three lines to include lands conveyed unto the State Roads Commission in Liber 311, Folio 521, (20) South 75 degrees 00' 00" West 256.00 feet, (21) South 11 degrees 30' 00" West 190.58 feet, (22) South 80 degrees 30' 00" East 440.98 feet to a point in or near the Westerly right of way line of Main Street, and thence, with said right of way line, (23) South 25 degrees 19' 00" West 671.00 feet to the point of beginning and passing over the place where the Northerly corporate limits as determined in 1964 proceed in a Westerly direction 205 feet short of the end thereof, the same containing 48.1987 acres. Being a portion of land which would extend the corporate limits of Union Bridge in a Northerly direction.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that from and after the effective date of this Resolution all persons residing in the area to be annexed, and the property therein, shall be and become residents of and property within The Town of Union Bridge and subject to the provisions of the Charter and Ordinances of The Town of Union Bridge.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of Union Bridge shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be published not fewer than four (4) times at not less than weekly intervals in a newspaper of general circulation in The Town of Union Bridge, together with a public notice that shall specify a time and place at which a public hearing will be held by the Mayor and Council upon the Resolution, which hearing shall be set for not less than fifteen (15) days after the fourth publication of the notices and to be held at the municipal office of the
