CHAPTER 60

(Senate Bill 989)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Pensions

FOR the purpose of restricting the amounts of certain pensions which may be paid by Charles County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Charles County
Section 58A(b)
Article 9 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1969 Edition and 1975 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 58A(b) of the Public Local Laws of Charles County being Article 9 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1969 Edition and 1975 Supplement, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 9

58A.

(b) Such persons who have held one or more of the elected public offices of Charles County enumerated in subsection (a) of this section for a combined total of four full terms shall be entitled to an annual retirement salary in an amount equal to the total of five percent (5%) of each of the highest annual salaries received by the person for each year he held office; provided, however, the maximum annual retirement salary shall not exceed eighty percent (80%) of the highest annual salary the person received while holding one of those offices, AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE AMOUNT OF ANY PENSION BEING PAID TO A PERSON BY REASON OF RETIREMENT FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH THE COUNTY SHALL BE SUBTRACTED FROM ANY RETIREMENT SALARY PAYABLE UNDER THIS SECTION.
