SUBTITLE 12. POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT GRANT PROGRAM.

18-1201.

THERE IS A PROGRAM OF POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT GRANTS IN THIS STATE THAT ARE AWARDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

18-1202.

THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM OF POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT FINANCIAL AID GRANTS.

18-1203.

(A) THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE ANY COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION IN DETERMINING STUDENT ELIGIBILITY.

(B) EACH APPLICANT FOR A POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT GRANT SHALL:

(1) BE ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION AT AN APPROVED PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY INSTITUTION;

(2) BE ENROLLED IN A FULL-TIME PROGRAM AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION;

(3) BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE; AND

(4) DEMONSTRATE TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD FINANCIAL NEED.

18-1204.

A POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT GRANT MAY BE AWARDED IN \$100 INCREMENTS. HOWEVER, THE AWARD FOR A SINGLE YEAR MAY NOT BE MORE THAN \$1,500.

18-1205.

A POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY STUDENT GRANT MAY BE USED:

(1) AT A PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY PROPRIETARY INSTITUTION IN THIS STATE THAT:

(I) IS APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION;

(II) ENROLLS AT LEAST 25 FULL-TIME STUDENTS, AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND

(III) OPERATES SOLELY WITHIN THE STATE;
