To become available immediately upon passage of this budget to supplement appropriation for Fiscal Year 1980, to replace the steam and condensate lines from the Power Plant to the Correctional Institution, the State Use Industries shops and the warehouse. The condensate line, found to be leaking in March 1979, threatens to undermine and cause a break in the steam line, which would result in a complete loss of steam to the Institution.
