(f) The prohibitions set forth hereinabove and the sanctions set forth hereinafter apply to both the seller and the purchaser.

2. (a) The Director of Energy Policy is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with other states for reciprocity with respect to the provisions of this Order. He shall then declare which jurisdictions have made such reciprocity agreements. As to such jurisdictions, and as to Virginia and the District of Columbia, gasoline purchases shall be made for vehicles bearing license plates from those jurisdictions in the same manner as if the vehicle were registered in Maryland; and

(b) Gasoline purchases by an operator of a vehicle bearing foreign registration plates from a jurisdiction other than Virginia and the District of Columbia which has not entered into a reciprocal agreement with the State of Maryland may be made on both odd and even numbered days.

3. The following vehicles shall be excluded from the provisions of the Order and gasoline may be purchased for them on both odd and even numbered days regardless of registration plate number:

(a) Authorized emergency vehicles as defined in Section 11-118 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland;

(b) Vehicles of municipal, county, State or Federal departments, public service companies and other authorized service vehicles as defined in Section 22-201 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, upon presentation of proper identification and in the case of vehicles of municipal, county, State or Federal departments, of a certificate issued by the Maryland State Police, Baltimore City Police Department, or a County Police Department, pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4(g) below;

(c) Funeral hearses, funeral limousines and funeral flower coaches, and any vehicle operated by a physician or nurse upon
