unexpended funds may be carried forward and expended in any subsequent fiscal year, subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works.

Article - Education Section 24-204(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Education

24-204.

- (a) (1) The Commission and the State Board of Education annually shall each prepare a budget request to provide funds to perform their duties under this subtitle.
- (2) The Commission may receive and spend any grant or gift budgeted or provided for it.
- (3) (1) THE COMMISSION IS ENCOURAGED TO MAKE USE OF ITS FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT, AND OTHER RESOURCES TO PROVIDE SERVICES THAT MAY GENERATE ADDITIONAL INCOME. ANY INCOME EARNED IN THAT MANNER SHALL BE CONSIDERED SPECIAL FUNDS FOR USE BY THE COMMISSION.
- (II) UNEXPENDED FUNDS MAY BE CARRIED FORWARD AND EXPENDED IN ANY SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
