

article and constructing a storm water or surface drainage system, the WSSC is empowered, from time to time, to issue bonds in denominations and for terms not exceeding 25 years and at rates as provided in § 4-104 of this title, the bonds to be the general obligations of the sanitary district guaranteed by both Prince George's and Montgomery counties, as the construction bonds of the WSSC are now guaranteed under the provisions of Chapter 122 of the Acts of 1918 and amendments to the [chapter] CHAPTER. The total amount of bonds for the construction of storm water or surface drainage systems outstanding shall at no time exceed the sum of \$1,000,000. No bond or part of any bond issued pursuant to this section in and for Prince George's County may be paid, appropriated, spent or in any manner applied to the construction of a storm drainage facility or system which is not included or in conformance with the current approved Capital Improvements Program of the WSSC.

(a) Beginning at the time that it is levied the benefit charge shall be paid annually by all properties that are required to pay the benefit charge for a period of years co-extensive WITH the period of maturity of the bonds the proceeds of which financed the construction of the water mains or sewers.

(b) (3) "Major projects" does not include a water main that:

(iii) Is [build] BUILT to avoid unnecessary and uneconomical duplication when a major project is constructed.

(b) If a commissioner or employee of the WSSC receives an ex parte communication concerning the merits of a case where the [commissioners or employee] COMMISSIONER'S OR EMPLOYEE'S determination or decision is required by law to be made only after a public hearing for interested parties:

(1) The substance of an oral ex parte communication shall be noted for purposes of the record; and

(2) The substance of a written ex parte communication shall be placed on the record.

(c) (1) The WSSC shall issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$1,500,000 in denominations and for terms as provided in § [4-4] 4-104 of this article.
