SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

21-507.

~~(e) In Carroll County, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, and Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.~~

(G) (1) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE ISSUANCE OF A WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(H) ~~IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL, BY ORDINANCE MAY PROHIBIT~~ A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT STAND FROM STANDING IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION IN THE COUNTY TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
