

Chapter 277 of the Acts of 2002

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of [4] 3 years and, at the end of June 30, [2006] 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

Article - Criminal Procedure

(a) The Advisory Board consists of the following [22] 24 25 members:

- (1) one member of the Senate appointed by the President;
- (2) one member of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker;
- (3) three members from the Judicial Branch of State government appointed by the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals;
- (4) the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention;
- (5) three members recommended by the Secretary;
- (6) two members who are executive officials from State, county, or municipal police units;
- (7) the Director of the Maryland Justice Analysis Center of the Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice of the University of Maryland;
- (8) two elected county officials;
- (9) the Attorney General;
- (10) ~~one two~~ elected ~~official of a municipal corporation~~ officials from separate municipal corporations;
- (11) one State's Attorney;
- (12) one member of the State Council on Child Abuse and Neglect recommended by the Council chairperson;
- (13) one representative of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, recommended by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (14) one representative of the Department of Juvenile Services recommended by the Secretary of Juvenile Services;
- (15) one representative from the Motor Vehicle Administration recommended by the Secretary of Transportation; [and]
- (16) THE STATE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER;
- (17) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY; AND
