

SEC. 9. The sum of nine thousand one hundred and fifty dollars annually, or as much thereof as may be needed is appropriated from the Fund known as the Surplus Revenue Fund to pay the Scholarships herein established. Appropriation.

CHAPTER II.

SEC. 1 Cheap Educational Tracts, Documents and Periodicals shall be issued to Teachers and others by the State Superintendent, as he shall deem expedient. Also Tracts explanatory of the School System of the State, containing such information as may be important to the advancement of sound instruction and good discipline. Educational Tracts.

SEC. 2. For the purchase, printing and distribution of such documents the annual sum of two hundred and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated from the Surplus Revenue Fund.

CHAPTER III.

SECTION 1. For the further encouragement of Universal Education, District Libraries ought to be established in each School District under the care of the Teacher as Librarian. For this purpose the sum of twenty dollars per annum is ordered to be paid to any School District, as Library money, as long as the people raise the same amount annually. School District Libraries.

The Books must be selected by the District Commissioner, from the Library list authorized by the State Board of Education. The amount required for Library money is appropriated from the Surplus Revenue Fund. How selected.

CHAPTER IV.

SECTION 1. For the further encouragement of Education, the State Superintendent is authorized Educational Journals.
