Which was read the first time ;

Also, the bill entitled, an Act repealing certain sections of the 29th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to special judges, and enacting other sections in lieu thereof ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the bill entitled, an additional supplement to an Act entitled, an Act authorizing the appointment of Commissioners for the regulation and improvement of the village of Greensborough, in Caroline county, passed January Session 1826, chapter 97 ;

Also, the Senate bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Pocomoke Bridge company ;

With proposed amendments ;

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Williams, from a select committee, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an Act to amend section two hundred and eighty of Article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled testamentary laws, relating to the sale of real estate by executors.

Mr. Robinson, from a select committee, reported favorably on the bill entitled, an Act to repeal an Act adding additional sections to the second Article of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel county, regulating the running at large of stock in and about the city of Annapolis.

Which was read the first time ;

The bill entitled, an Act to Incorporate the German Fire Insurance company.

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to amend the charter of the Western Maryland Railroad company,

Was taken up for consideration upon its second reading.
