In the 7th line of the 6th section, after the words drafted man, insert "or person furnishing a representative substitute ;"

Which was adopted ;

Also, submitted the following amendment :

At the end of the sixth section as amended, add the words, "or any other similar one which shall hereafter be made."

Mr. Harris submitted the following :

Sec. 6, in line 7, after the word "substitute," insert, or his authorized agent or attorney ;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Soper, from the committee on Ways and Means, submitted the following :

4th. Strike out the preamble and title, and insert the following as the title of the bill :

A bill entitled, an Act to provide bounty for soldiers entering the service of the United States to fill the quotas of Maryland under the call of the President of the United States, of December 1864, and under future calls ;"

Which was adopted ;

The question then being upon concurring in the amendments of the Senate as above amended, it was decided in the affirmative.
