

Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The Senate bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Pocomoke Bridge Company,

Was taken up for consideration upon its third reading.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, submitted the following:

Amend section 6 by striking out all after the word "to" in in the 13th line down to the word "and" in the same line, and inserting therein the following:—"One vote for every share of stock which he, she or they may hold to the number of not exceeding five, one vote for every five shares exceeding five to the number of fifty, and one vote for every ten shares exceeding fifty, but in no case shall a stockholder vote more than twenty votes;

Which was rejected.

Also, the following amendment:

Amend section 11, by inserting after the word "Citizens" in the first line, the words "and residents;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Mules submitted the following:

Section 11, line 7, strike out the word "fifty" and insert the word "forty;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Jones submitted the following amendment:

Amend section 12, by striking out the word "seven" in the 3d line and inserting the word "six" therein;

Which was adopted.

Also the following amendment:

Amend section 13, by striking out the word "Legislature" in the 1st line and inserting "General Assembly;"

Which was adopted.

The bill having been read a third time was passed by yeas and nays as follow;
