On motion of Mr. Slothower,

One thousand copies of the bill entitled, an Act to provide bounty for soldiers entering the service of the United States to fill the quotas of Maryland, under the call of the President of the United States, of December 1864, and under future calls, was ordered to be printed in pamphlet form.

Amend Section 5, by inserting in line 9, after the word "convenient" the words "on the same day of the week in each year thereafter."

Amend section 9, by adding after the word "currency" in line 4, the following; and the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at pleasure."

Mr. Williams moved to amend the amendment by striking out the word "Legislature" and inserting "General Assembly;"

Decided in the affirmative.
