

Mr. Lee, of Baltimore city, from Select committee, reported favorably on a Senate bill entitled, an Act to amend the 5th section of the 77th article of the Code of Public General Laws of this State entitled, "State Wharfinger and Wharves;"

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Comegys, from a Select committee, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an Act to empower the commissioners of Kent county to charge an annual rent for the use of the county wharf situated in Gray's Iron Creek, in Kent county;

Which was read the first time.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following house bill:

A supplement to an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Hall Springs and Harford Railway company.

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments;"

Amend by adding additional section;

Section 3rd, and be it enacted, that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
