Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to report a bill to Incorporate the Swan Meadows Oil, Coal, Iron and Manufacturing company.

Also, leave to report a bill to Incorporate the Deep Creek and Cherry Tree Meadows Coal, Coal Oil and Lumber company of Allegany county.

On motion of Mr. Kirk,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to amend an Act to Incorporate the Columbia and Port Deposit Railroad company, passed at January session, 1858, chapter 103, and re-enacted by a supplement passed at January session, 1864, chapter 31.

On motion of Mr. Malone,

Leave was granted the Somerset county delegation to report a bill, to increase the compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset county for keeping and boarding prisoners in the county jail.

On motion of Mr. Lee, of Baltimore city,

Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill to allow the United Fire Department of Baltimore city to donate their funds.

On motion of Mr. Smith of Allegany,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means, to report a bill to facilitate the collection of State taxes in the city of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Smith, of Frederick,

Ordered, That it be entered upon the Journal that Eli Smith, one of the committee Clerks, is absent on account of the death of a relative.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to Incorporate the Baltimore and Herring Run Passenger Railway company;
