

It was recommitted to the Somerset county delegation.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed March session, 1864, chapter 397, entitled, an Act for the relief of Seth W. Warfield, late Collector of Taxes in Howard county, and Elias W. Frost, Collector of Taxes in Howard District of Anne Arundel county,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, at or near Mount Washington, in Baltimore county,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Harris submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the last section;

Which was rejected.

The bill entitled, an Act to empower the Commissioners of Kent county, to charge an annual rent for the use of the county wharf, situated on Gray's Inn Creek, in Kent county,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Comegys submitted the following amendment:

Section 1, 3d line, after the word "charge" strike out the words, "an annual" and insert the words, "or wharfage" after the word rent;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Harris submitted the following amendment:

Strike out section 3d.

Which was rejected.

The bill having been read a second time was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act authorizing the Register of Wills of Worcester county, to have certain books of record indexed,

Was taken up for consideration upon its second reading.

On motion of Mr. Anderson,

Said bill was referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Herring Run Passenger Railway company,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.
