

On motion of Mr. Poteet,

The Order of the Day, being the bill in relation to the inspection of fish in the City of Baltimore,

Was postponed for half an hour.

On motion of Mr. McCauley,

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal that Jesse A. Kirk, of Cecil, is absent from his seat on account of sickness.

On motion of Mr. Lusby,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation,

To introduce a bill to repeal the first Section of chapter 32 of an Act entitled, an Act to regulate the Inspection and Cording of Firewood in Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Nairne,

Leave was granted the Worcester county delegation,

To report a bill authorizing the Register of Wills of Worcester county, in the recess of the Orphans' Court of said county, to pass any account or claim against the estate of a deceased person for any amount not exceeding one hundred dollars, and on the return of any inventory of the personal estate of a deceased person, may pass an order for the sale of the property contained therein.

On motion of Mr. Norris,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate Freedom Lodge, No. 112, of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, at Freedom, Carroll county, Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Mules,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill authorizing the hearing at the present term of the Court of Appeals, the appeal of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, from an order of the Circuit Court of Baltimore city, granting an injunction at the prayer of Victor Clunet and others, and the speedy hearing and determination of all appeals in the matter of the opening of a street in continuation of Holliday street.

On motion of Mr. Agnew,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to amend and re-enact section sixteen of Article fifty of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the pay of Jurors.

On motion of Mr. Miller, of Anne Arundel,
