

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the McCullough Iron Company, of Cecil county.

On motion of Mr. Sherry,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to incorporate a company, to be called the "Lincoln Coal and Iron Company."

On motion of Mr. Sherry,

Leave was granted the Allegany county delegation to report a bill in relation to the compensation of the Clerk to the Commissioners of Allegany county.

On motion of Mr. Wooden,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means, to report a bill, authorizing Justices of the Peace of the several counties and the city of Baltimore, to charge mileage when required to leave their respective offices to take acknowledgments of deeds and all other instruments.

On motion of Mr. Sherry,

Leave was granted the Allegany county delegation to report a bill, empowering the Commissioners of Allegany county to alter and correct the assessment of certain lands in District No. 8, of said county, so as to refund to a certain Sarah Anne McKaig, of said county, certain monies by her erroneously paid.

On motion of Mr. Fawcett,

Leave was granted a select committee of five, to report a bill, prohibiting the sale of spirituous liquors in the several counties of this State, on the day of election ;

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Fawcett, Rinehart, Morris, McCullough and Lee of Queen Anne's, said committee.

Mr. Buhrman submitted the following resolution :

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all committees whose duties require their absence from the daily sessions of the Senate or House of Delegates, be allowed by the committee on Claims, their regular per diem and actual traveling expenses, but no extra per diem or mileage ;
