

Providing for support of schools, preservation of school funds, location and regulation of school houses, to the committee on Education.

Granting divorces, fees or salaries, interest on money, to the committee on the Judiciary.

Places of voting and boundaries of districts, to the committee on Elections.

Providing for the sale of real estate of minors and others under legal disabilities, giving effect to informal or invalid deeds or wills, to the committee on Judiciary.

Refunding money paid into the State Treasury and releasing persons from their debts or obligations to the State, to the committee on Ways and Means.

Establishing or locating roads, and building or repairing bridges, to the committee on Roads and Highways.

For the registration of votes and making effective the provisions of the Constitution disfranchising certain persons or disqualifying them from holding office, to the committee on Judiciary.

Protecting the property of the wife from the debts of her husband, and securing the same to her issue after death, to the committee on Judiciary.

Protecting from execution a reasonable amount of property of the debtor, not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500,) to the committee on Judiciary.

Providing for a simple and uniform system of charges in the offices of Clerks of Courts and Registers of Wills, to the committee on Judiciary.

Requiring Presidents, Directors, &c., of corporations, teachers, attorneys, jurors and others, to take the oath of allegiance to the United States, to the committee on the Judiciary.

For the registration of births, deaths, marriages, &c., to the committee on Public Records.

For the trial of causes in case of disqualification of judges, to the committee on Judiciary.

Removal of causes to obtain a fair and impartial trial, to the committee on Judiciary.

The compensation of special judges, to the committee on Judiciary.

Appointment of Road Supervisors by County Commissioners, to the committee on Roads and Highways.
