A bill entitled, an Act to provide for making new indexes, for copying general indexes, and for binding and covering books containing civil, equity and land dockets; and, also, mortgage and chattel records of Baltimore county;

Endorsed, passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Section 1, strike out in the 4th and 5th lines, the words "from the year eighteen hundred and fifty-one to eighteen hundred and fifty-three," and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "from the first day of December, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, to the first day of June, eighteen hundred and fifty-three;" also, by striking out from the 6th and 7th lines of the 1st section, the words "from the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three, to eighteen hundred and fifty-eight," and inserting in lieu thereof the following, "from the thirtieth day of June, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, to the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight."

Section 2, strike out the word "Law" in the 3d line of said section, and insert in its place the word "Land."

The amendments were concurred in, and the bill as amended passed by yeas and nays as follow:
