A bill entitled, an Act for the relief of the Mayor and Council, and citizens of Hagerstown, and authorizing the raising by taxation the sum of \$35,000 for the purposes therein mentioned ;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas with proposed amendments."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED :

In the 1st section sixth and seventh lines strike out the words "in the name of the said Mayor and Council of Hagerstown," and after the word "bonds" in the sixth line, insert the following: "bearing an interest of six per cent. per annum, signed by the Mayor and by the Clerk of said Mayor and Council, and sealed with the seal of said corporation," and in the eleventh line of same section by inserting the word "dollars" after the word "thousand."

And in the 2nd Section by striking out all after the word "levy" in the third line and insert in lieu thereof the following: "on all the assessable property of said town a tax sufficient to liquidate or pay the whole amount of said bonds, (\$35,000,) or any part thereof, and the interest thereon, accruing from time to time, as it may become due; and also, if deemed expedient by the said Mayor and City Council, to establish a sinking fund adequate to liquidation or redemption of said bonds, in a period not exceeding twenty years, said tax to be levied and collected as other taxes of said corporation are levied and collected.
