Ordered, That the Governor is respectfully requested to furnish this House the data upon which such credits were distributed to the different counties and the city of Baltimore, and such other information touching the subject of said distribution as he may deem proper ; and that the committee heretofore appointed be and the same is hereby relieved from the further consideration of the subject embraced in the order referred to them ;
