## ACCOMPANYING THE GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE.

BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD,

President's Office, Baltimore, Nov. 30th, 1861.

To His Excellency, Thos. H. Hicks,

Governor of Maryland:

SIR:—In the multiplicity of engagements with which my time has been recently occupied, I omitted to send you a copy of the statement submitted by the Board of Directors to the annual meeting of the Stockholders of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, held on the 18th instant. I beg to hand you this statement herewith.

You will perceive, under the circumstances in which the Company is placed, the impossibility of making a regular and detailed report of its affairs for the past fiscal year. I trust, however, that ere long we may be enabled to present a full and accurate report.

I hope, in a short time, to have the pleasure of a personal interview with you, when I shall be able to inform you of the exertions which have been made to re-open the road, and of our prospects of attaining this most desirable result.
