

a bill to repeal An act passed June 19, 1861, entitled, An act to add the following sections to article 6th of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to election districts in Caroline county.

On motion of Mr. Wolf,

Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to report a bill to repeal section 879, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the city of Baltimore, and to insert in lieu thereof a section to provide that certain duties which are by sections 874, 875, 876, 877 and 878 of said article, imposed on the auditor.

On motion of Mr. Price,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to report a bill to amend the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws by enabling the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to endorse the bonds of the Western Maryland Rail Road Company to additional amount;

Also, to report a bill entitled, An act authorising the Western Maryland Rail Road Company to increase its capital stock, and to issue an additional amount thereof.

Mr. Price, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend the 16th article, of the Code of Public General Laws by adding thereto the following sections, relating to the powers of courts of chancery in selling land;

Also, upon the bill entitled, An act to add a new section to the 29th article, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to courts, authorising the issue of *subpoena duces tecum* in certain cases;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Phelps, from the committee on Ways and Means, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend sections 947 and 949, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, relating to licensing of wood hucksters;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Ensor, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably upon the Senate bill entitled, An act supplementary to an act to incorporate the Isabella Gas Works of Frederick city;

Which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore Tobacco Works;
