

Mr. Mathews, from the same committee, reported favorably upon the bill entitled, An act to make valid a deed from Susan E. B. Yates, formerly Susan E. B. Etherington to Thomas H. Harris, of Kent county;

Also, upon the bill entitled, An act to amend section 37, of article 66, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Negroes, relating to the escape of slaves by being transported on railroads, steamboats and other vessels;

Also, upon the Senate bill entitled, An act to repeal the 1, 2, and 7th sections, of article 52, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the Keeper of the Chancery Records, and to enact the following as a substitute therefor;

Also, unfavorably upon the bill entitled, An act to repeal the 33rd section, of the 37th article, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to attachments, issued by justices of the peace, against witnesses failing to attend or refusing to answer questions, at the execution of commissions to take evidence from other States, and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

Submitting, as a substitute, a bill entitled, An act to amend the 37th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by repealing the 33rd section thereof, relating to commissions to take evidence from other States, and substituting therefor a new section;

Which were severally read the first time.

Mr. Hardcastle, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to repeal an act to add another section to article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to election districts in Caroline county, and substitute therefor the following:

Which was read the first, and by special order, three-fourths concurring, a second and third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
