AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In line 46, on page 3, after the word "purposes," insert: "the said Treasurer of the Board shall every six months, on the first days of January and July, in each and every year, render to the said Board of Commissioners an account of his receipts and disbursements, with the vouchers therefor, during said period which account shall be verified by the affidavit of said Treasurer, and the said Commissioners shall thereupon examine said account, and if they find the same to be correct shall certify said account and send the same to the City Council of Baltimore city, within ten days after said account shall have been rendered by the Treasurer, the said Commissioners retaining a correct copy thereof with a copy of their certificate to be filed among the papers of their office."

In the 806th section, after the word "Commissioners," in the 8th line insert the words: "shall be elected by the General Assembly on joint ballot, and."

Amend 1st section by striking out in lines 11 and 12, the following words: "and shall receive each a salary of two thousand dollars per annum, payable quarterly," and inserting the following words: "and the said Commissioners shall meet three days in each week, and whenever convened by the Mayor, and shall receive each four dollars per day, for each day they shall be in session."

In lines 4 and 5, on page 4, strike out the names of "Brantz Mayer, Job Smith, Henry S. Lankford and George Cassard."

Strike out all after the figures "807," in 2d section, down to and including the word "so," in the 7th line, and insert the words, "the said Commissioners so."

In the 5th line, strike out "eight," and insert "four."
