

On motion of Mr. Price,
Was referred to the committee on Currency.

The bill entitled, An act to amend the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by repealing sections 4, 5, 7, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20 and 25, and re-enacting the same with amendments, relating to the time of the election of Mayor and City Council of Baltimore;

Was read the first time.

The bill entitled, An act to amend article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, by repealing sections 552, 553, 554, 556, 565 and 566, in relation to the inspection and cording of fire-wood, and substituting in lieu thereof the following sections, relating to the same subject;

Mr. Taylor proposed the following:

In the 9th section, lines 3 and 4, strike out the words "one hundred," and insert "fifty;"

In section 9, line 4, after the word "dollars," insert, "and on the expiration of one year from the date thereof, an additional sum of fifty dollars; the failure of payment of which shall be deemed and taken as a resignation of the office of Inspector;"

Which were adopted.

Mr. Dunbar proposed the following:

In section 4, line 3, strike out the word "April," and insert "May;"

In section 5, line 8, after the word "one-half," strike out "so recovered to," and insert, "for the use of the informer;"

Which were adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then, by special order, three-fourths concurring, read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
