Mr. Kemp, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower Gustavus A. T. Wright, collector of school tax, in district number 32, of Queen Anne's county to complete his collections;

Which were severally read the first time.

Mr. White, from a select committee, reported unfavorably upon the bill entitled, An act to repeal the 107th section, of the 1st article, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the superintendent of the National road in Allegany county, and inserting the following in lieu thereof; and

Submitted as a substitute, a bill entitled, An act to repeal 107 and 108th sections, of the 1st article, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the superintendent of the National road in Allegany county, and re-enact the same with amendments thereto;

The report was adopted, and the substitute read the first time.

Mr. J. J. Bowie, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act for the protection of fowls and birds against hawks;

Which was read the first, and by special order, three-fourths concurring, a second and third time, and rejected (for want of a constitutional majority) as follow:
