

The title, as amended, was then adopted, and the bill sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled, An act to authorise the Treasurer of the State, to pay on the warrant of the Comptroller to the Treasurer of the Maryland Colonization Society, the sum appropriated by chapter 425, of the act of Assembly of January session, 1858;

Was read the third time, and rejected (for want of a Constitutional majority) follow:
