The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, An act to authorise the county commissioners for Frederick county to borrow money to furnish the new court house;

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Trustees of the German Reformed Church in Emmittsburg;

Which were read and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

Also, a bill entitled, An act to appoint and authorise certain persons in Kent county, to purchase real estate in Kent county, from Samuel E. Baker, of said county, to be held in trust for the Methodist Episcopal Church, on Kent circuit, for the purpose of holding camp meetings, or other meetings, on the same, Sunday School festivals, &c.;

Also, a bill entitled, An act to provide for the filling of vacancies in office, by the Governor, in all cases not otherwise provided for by the Constitution and laws of the State;
