

On motion of Mr. Magruder,

Leave was granted a select committee, composed of Messrs. Magruder, Nutwell and Duvall, to report a bill to repeal section 8, of the act of January session 1858, chapter 301, entitled, An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, in the city of Baltimore, and to prescribe the duties of the inspectors and other purposes, and section 535, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, for the city of Baltimore, relating to the inspection of tobacco.

On motion of Mr. Magruder,

Leave was granted the same select committee, to report a bill to amend section 501, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, for the city of Baltimore, relating to the inspection of tobacco, and the appointment and term of office of the tobacco inspectors.

On motion of Mr. Stockdale,

Leave was granted the Baltimore city and county delegations to report a bill to be entitled, An act to grade and improve West Baltimore street from the Calverton road to the western limits of the Maryland Cattle Scales.

On motion of Mr. White,

Leave was granted the Allegany county delegation to report a bill to amend the 95th section, of article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to constables in Allegany county.

Leave was granted the committee on Inspections to report a bill entitled, An act to amend article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of Baltimore city relating to the inspection of lumber, by repealing sections 474, 475, 476, 477, 478, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484 and 485 of said article, and substituting other sections therefor.

Leave was granted the committee on Currency to report a bill to amend the charter of the Hagerstown Bank.
