9-705. COMPOSITION.

THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 3 EX OFFICIO MEMBERS:

(1) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY;

(2) THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES; AND

(3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE PLANNING.

In item (1) of this section, the proper name of the Commission on the Capital City is substituted for the former, incorrect reference to the "Capital City Commission".

9-706. CHAIRMAN.

FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN.
