

THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE CALL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL.

(B) STAFF AND OTHER SERVICES.

(1) THE COUNCIL MAY NOT EMPLOY A STAFF, BUT THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SERVICES FOR THE COUNCIL.

(2) THE COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE ANY UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST, TO PROVIDE THE COUNCIL WITH PROFESSIONAL OR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

9-708. AUTHORITY OF BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

THE COUNCIL ACTS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY AND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

9-709. POWERS AND DUTIES OF COUNCIL.

(A) SUPERVISION OF STUDIES.

AT THE DIRECTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, THE COUNCIL SHALL SUPERVISE THE PREPARATION OF ANY STUDY, REPORT, OR SURVEY THAT MAY CONTRIBUTE TO THE PRESERVATION OF THE INTEGRITY OF ANNAPOLIS.

(B) MANAGEMENT OF PACA HOUSE AND PACA GARDENS.

THE COUNCIL SUCCEEDS THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STATE UNDER:

(1) THE LEASE THAT WAS EXECUTED BY HISTORIC ANNAPOLIS, INC., AND THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST ON FEBRUARY 21, 1969, FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF PACA HOUSE; AND

(2) THE LEASE THAT WAS EXECUTED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, HISTORIC ANNAPOLIS, INC., AND THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST ON NOVEMBER 17, 1972, FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF PACA GARDENS.
