

(1) ADVISE THE GOVERNMENT HOUSE TRUST ABOUT ACQUISITION AND DISPLAY OF THE OBJECTS;

(2) KEEP A CONTINUING INVENTORY OF THE OBJECTS;

(3) INSURE THE OBJECTS; AND

(4) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESERVATION OF THE OBJECTS.

1-123. COMMISSION TO SEEK ADVICE.

IN PERFORMING ITS RESPONSIBILITIES IN OR ON THE PREMISES OF ANY STATE BUILDING, THE COMMISSION SHALL SEEK THE ADVICE OF:

(1) THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES FOR ANY STATE BUILDING USED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT;

(2) THE GOVERNOR FOR ANY STATE BUILDING USED BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT; AND

(3) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS FOR ANY STATE BUILDING USED BY THE JUDICIAL BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

PART III. MARYLAND MANUAL.

1-126. PUBLICATION.

(A) COMPILATION AND EDITING.

EVERY 2 YEARS, THE STATE ARCHIVES SHALL COMPILE AND EDIT A MARYLAND MANUAL THAT CONTAINS:

(1) A COPY OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION;

(2) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH OFFICER OF THE STATE OR A COUNTY WHO IS:

(I) ELECTED;

(II) APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; OR

(III) APPOINTED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS;

AND

(3) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION, THE STATE ARCHIVIST CONSIDERS NECESSARY.
